Case Study Profiles

Below are brief overviews of three fictional student profiles you may choose from for your assignment.

- Elementary (Grade 3): "Liam" - Reading comprehension struggles, inconsistent classroom behavior, English learner with strong oral skills but reading gaps.
- Middle Grades (Grade 7): "Sophia" - Difficulty with math problem-solving and homework completion, diagnosed ADHD, culturally responsive supports needed due to recent family immigration.
- High School (Grade 10): "Malik" - Below grade level in writing, frequent tardiness, enjoys technology-based learning, has an IEP with post-secondary transition goals focused on vocational training.

SMART Goal Writing Guide

SMART goals are: Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, and Time-bound. Example academic goal: 'Liam will increase reading comprehension scores from 60% to 80% on weekly checks within 6 weeks.' Example behavior goal: 'Sophia will submit at least 4 out of 5 homework assignments per week for 8 consecutive weeks.'
