- Educators who are ethical professionals
- Promote and foster ethics and ethical instruction
- Championing the MCEE
- Raising awareness of the professional responsibility for ethical practice
- Equipping educators in ethical understanding
- Supporting educators' ethical decision making



Educator ID Clearinghouse

- National collection point for professional educator discipline actions
- Provide NASDTEC member state/jurisdiction with a notification of an action taken against the license
- Protect the interests of children served by the professional education community
- Associate Members (EPPs and LEAs) may subscribe

KnowledgeBase - New items to Assist with USDOE Title IX Regulations

- Minimum Degree Required
- Does degree program require state Board (or comparable out-of-state board) approval?
- Does degree program require Specialized Accreditation?
- Minimum Preparation
 - Subject Matter Content (with number of minimum hours if applicable)
 - General Pedagogy (with number of minimum hours if applicable)
 - Content Area Pedagogy (with number of minimum hours if applicable)
- Validity in Years (how long the license lasts before renewal)
- Renewable
- NASDTEC Classifications
- Reciprocity Agreements
- Fees for license application

Prevention and Correction

- Licensing Agencies and LEAs
